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WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP OCTOBER EDITION

In October, we continued to work for every human. In Gaza and Lebanon, Human Appeal is responding to the ongoing crises, providing families with hot meals, clean drinking water, and medical care. We ran breast cancer awareness sessions in Gaza, and distributed sleeping kits, hygiene kits, and food parcels in Lebanon. We responded to the floods in Nigeria with food packages and health and hygiene kits. In Pakistan, we inaugurated the girl's school we built, and conducted an eye-health camp where we provided cataract surgeries. We distributed back to school kits in Somalia, as well as training a water management committee and organising a cataract surgery campaign. In Somalia, we distributed Aqiqa meat in Mogadishu, and are distributing non-food items

and water. In Sudan, we distributed hot meals, parcels of bread, hygiene kits and food parcels, and supported livelihoods by providing a wage for community support tasks. In Syria, our mobile clinic, Al-Zohoor health centre and Al Imaan Hospital provided medical care to displaced Syrians, and we welcomed 800 displaced families to Al-Yasameen village. We are constructing a mosque and a water well in a Syrian community, and this month we celebrated the completion of Al-Zohoor school. In Yemen, we provided water collection tanks to coffee farmers in Yemen, along with coffee tree seedlings and tools. We also delivered food baskets and shelter kits to families affected by recent floods in Yemen.

GAZA

We've been working in Gaza since 1991 and we remain on the ground with the Palestinian people, delivering every single day during this emergency.

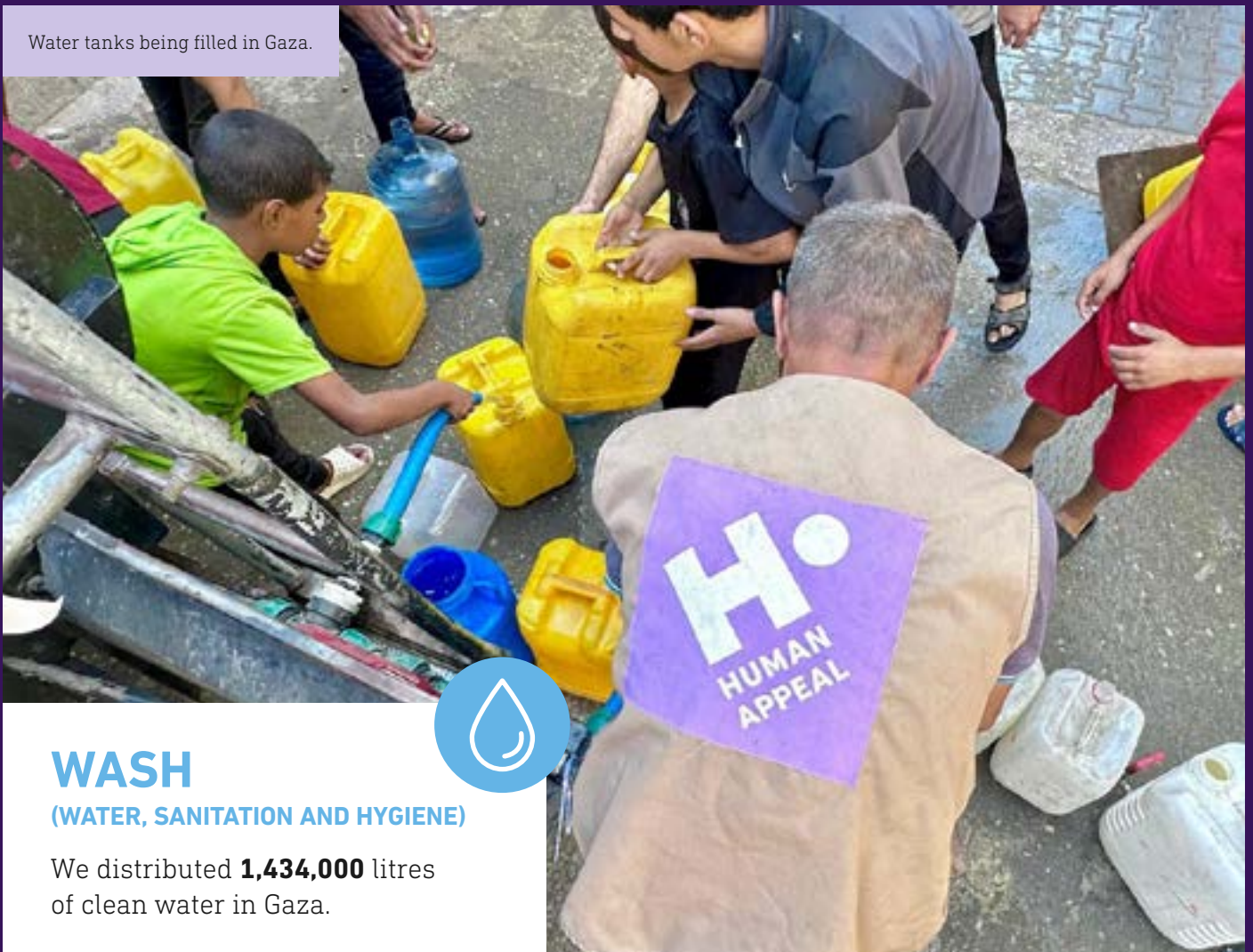

FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **752,648** hot meals in Gaza.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We distributed **1,434,000** litres of clean water in Gaza.

HEALTH



As part of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, Human Appeal organised three breast cancer awareness sessions on 14th October for **70** displaced women, focusing on early-detection, self-examination, breast cancer prevention.

Our mobile clinics provided care to **2,382** patients.

LEBANON



EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In Lebanon, Human Appeal has been distributing sleeping kits to families that have been displaced from their homes, helping them to sleep comfortably despite the circumstances. So far, we have distributed **1,220** mattresses, **1,928** blankets, and **520** pillows.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Human Appeal distributed **28,551** hot meals, **250** cold meals, and **475** food parcels across school shelters in the South of Lebanon.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal distributed **929** gallons of clean drinking water and **922** hygiene kits, helping families to stay clean and to stay hydrated despite being forced away from the facilities of their homes.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE/SHELTER



Following a rapids needs assessment, Human Appeal is planning to renovate Al Iman School to accommodate **150-200** displaced people, including the construction of a clinic.

NIGERIA



EMERGENCY RESPONSE

After the devastating floods in Nigeria, we supported **1,100** people with food packages and hygiene kits.

EDUCATION



We inaugurated a newly rebuilt girls' school in Chitratopi, attended by Human Appeal's Country Director and local officials, including the Minister for Higher Education and the Minister for Information Technology in the Azad-Jammu Kashmir region. It is now open to students.

HEALTH

Human Appeal Pakistan conducted a two-day eye-health camp in the Bagh District, providing medical treatment for optical issues and cataract surgeries. Treatment was provided to **838** patients, and **116** cataract surgeries were conducted, with glasses and eye drops provided where necessary to people with far-sightedness.

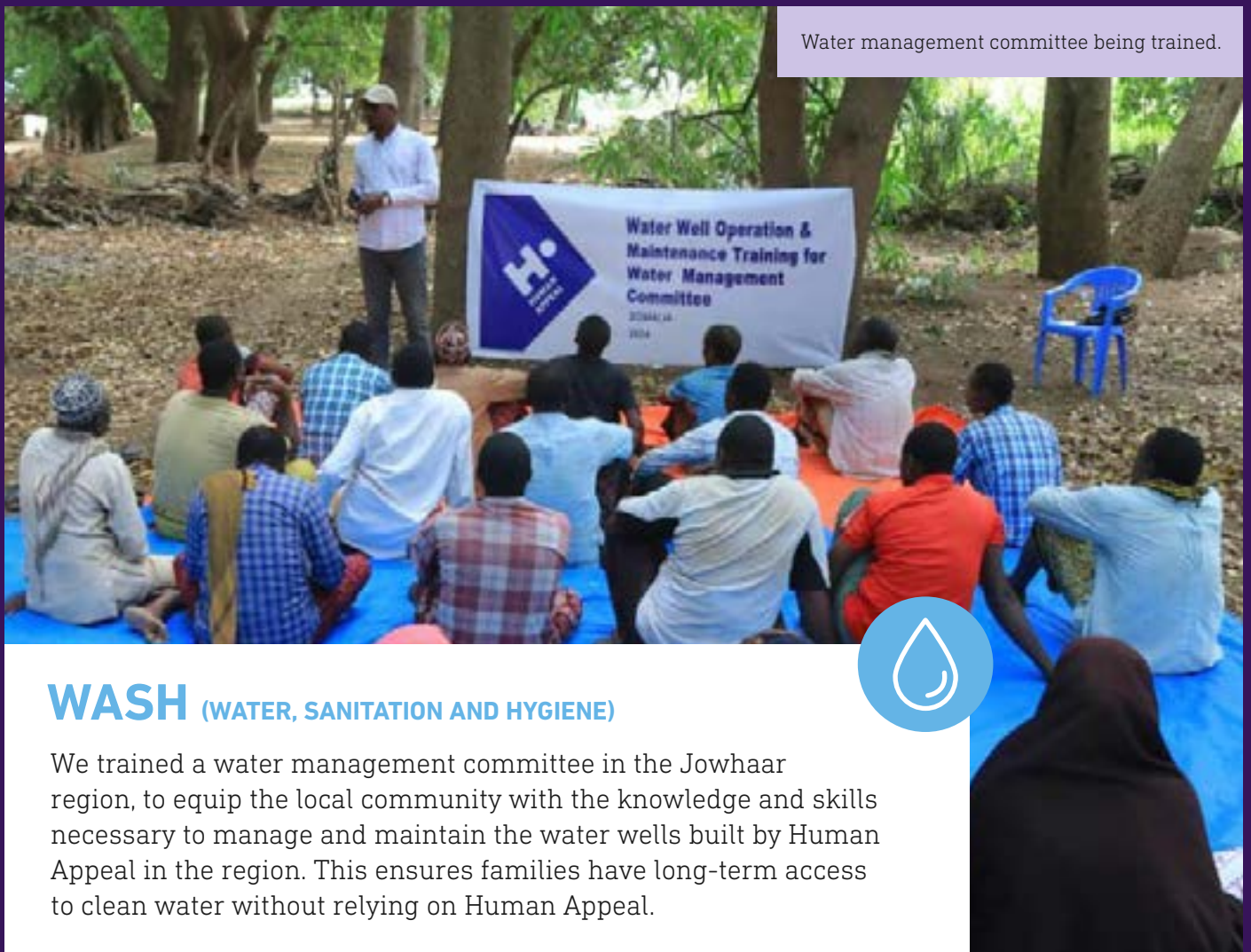


EDUCATION



Human Appeal distributed back-to-school kits to **441** students in Somalia in Mogadishu. Each school kit is a school bag that contains notebooks and stationery, with school uniforms provided to children as well.

WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



We trained a water management committee in the Jowhaar region, to equip the local community with the knowledge and skills necessary to manage and maintain the water wells built by Human Appeal in the region. This ensures families have long-term access to clean water without relying on Human Appeal.

FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal distributed fresh meat to **176** families in the Kahda district of Mogadishu, as part of our Aqiqa distributions.



HEALTH



Our cataract surgery campaign treated **381 patients**, and an additional **2,705 people** received medical care for various eye health issues.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE



Human Appeal is currently preparing to distribute non-food item (NFI) kits and provide access to clean water via water trucks to **1,000** flood-affected people in the Mogadishu region, as well as providing **700** people with cash transfers.

SUDAN



HEALTH

Since August, Human Appeal has distributed **9,000** hot meals on a daily basis in Khartoum and District 76, providing **2,000** families with a reliable source of nutritious food.

FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal has been distributing freshly baked bread to families in Sudan ever since the crisis began over 1 year ago, having distributed over a million pieces of bread so far. During October, we **19,200** pieces of bread.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal distributed **800** non-food item and hygiene kits in the Althawra Karrari locality in Omdurman.



LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal is supporting local livelihoods in Omdurman by supporting **2,100** people with wages for community tasks like cleaning and weeding forests, rehabilitating sidewalks, and participating in school awareness campaigns.

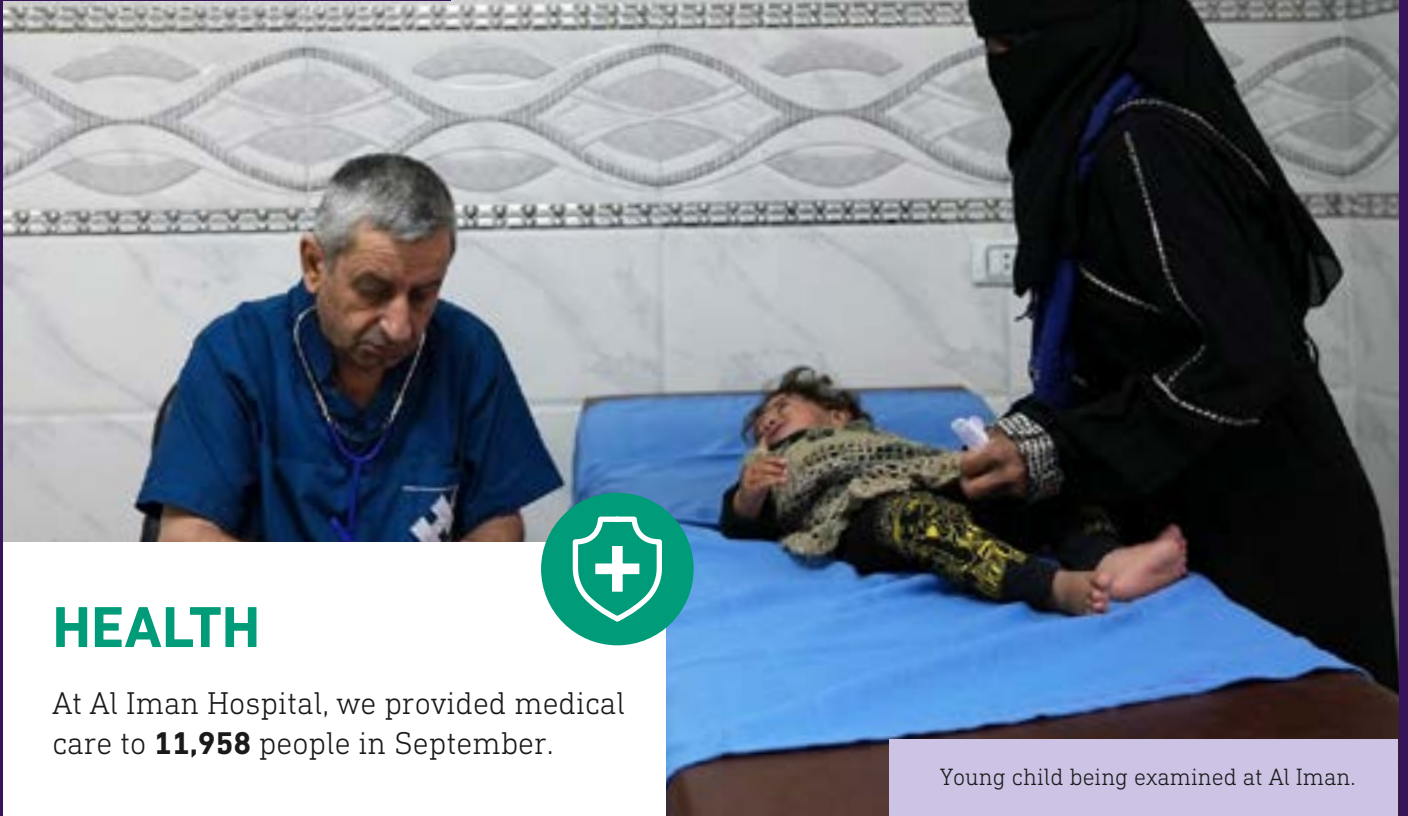


FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal distributed **180** food parcels in Bahri, as part of a planned distribution of over **700** food parcels. Each food parcel contains not just food items like vegetables, rice or lentils, but also contains cooking oil, tea and sugar, in quantities enough to last each family a number of days.



SYRIA



HEALTH

At Al Iman Hospital, we provided medical care to **11,958** people in September.

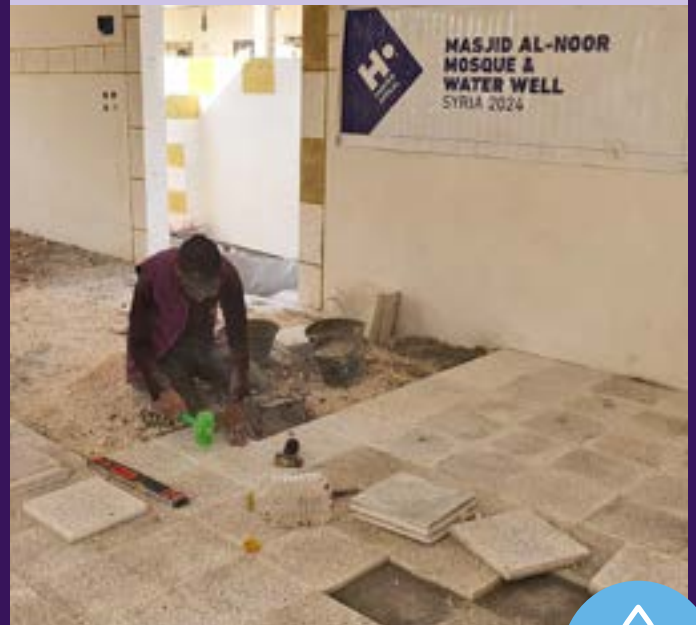

SHELTER

Human Appeal welcomed over **800** displaced families to new homes in Al-Yasameen, the third village built by Human Appeal. As winter approaches, these families will be able to avoid the chill that seeps through the cloth walls of tents. The psychological support team distributed balloons to children, and first aid to residents who have been suffering psychological pressure, while the mobile clinic provided free medical services and examinations.

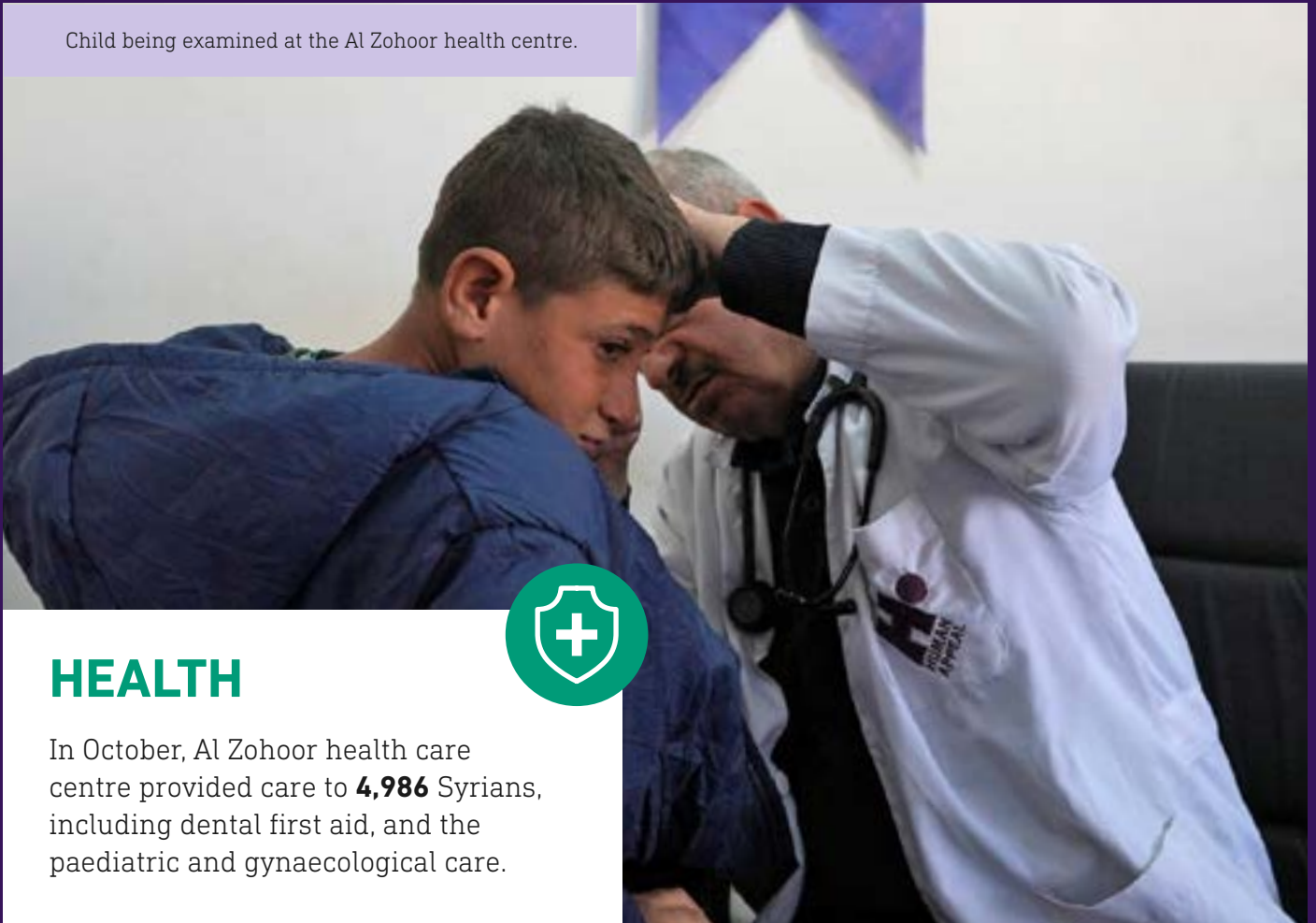

SPIRITUAL/WASH

HEALTH

In October, Al Zohoor health care centre provided care to **4,986** Syrians, including dental first aid, and the paediatric and gynaecological care.

HEALTH

Over the course of October, our mobile clinic provided free healthcare to **2,087** patients, distributed across various displacement camps in northwestern Syria. The mobile clinic provided the residents of these camps with the services of a general physician, a pharmacy providing free medicine, a community health worker, and a gynaecology clinic.

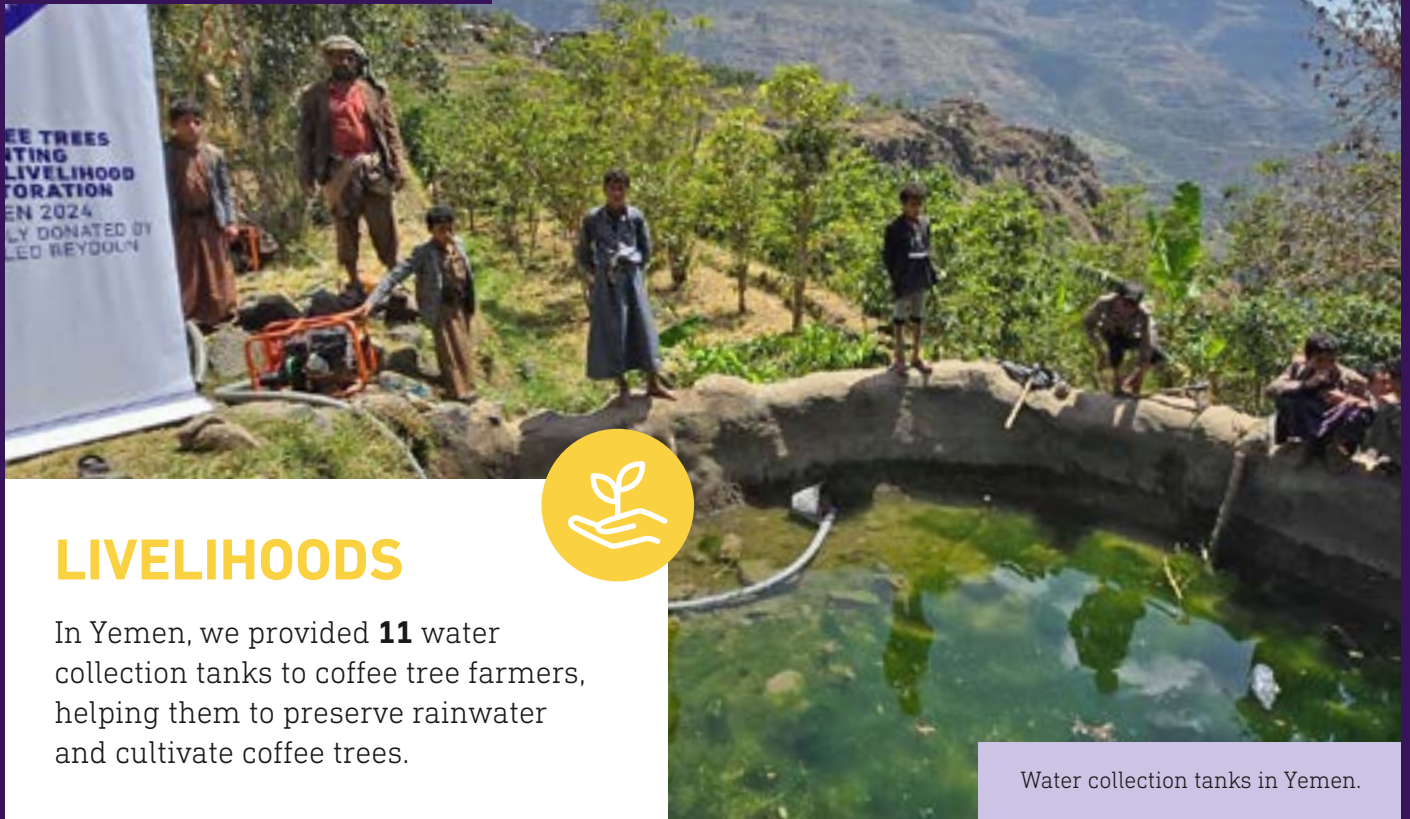

LIVELIHOODS

In Yemen, we provided **11** water collection tanks to coffee tree farmers, helping them to preserve rainwater and cultivate coffee trees.
