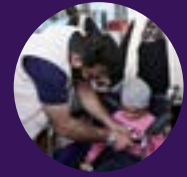

In November, Human Appeal continued its mission to deliver vital support to vulnerable communities around the world. From responding to devastating floods in Bosnia to empowering entrepreneurs in Iraq, our impact reached far and wide. In Gaza, Lebanon, Syria, and Sudan, essential food, clean water, medical aid, and shelter were provided to those most in need. Meanwhile, projects in Pakistan, Senegal, Turkey, and Yemen focused on education, sanitation, and improving living conditions for children, orphans, and refugees. These efforts reflect Human Appeal's ongoing commitment to alleviating suffering and building brighter futures for all every single month.

BOSNIA



EMERGENCY RESPONSE



During September, Human Appeal distributed food parcels and hygiene kits to families affected by the floods.

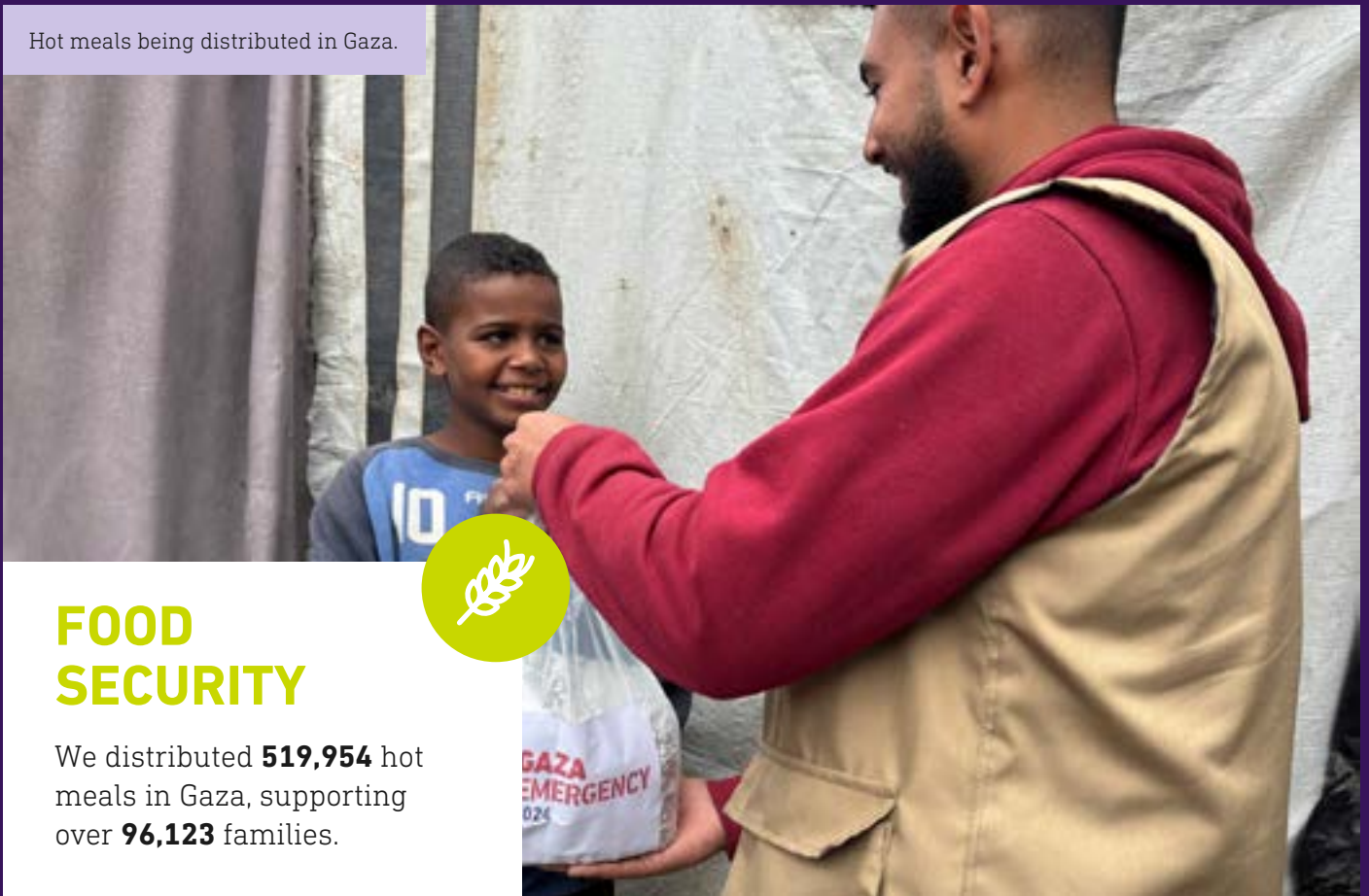

FOOD SECURITY



We distributed **519,954** hot meals in Gaza, supporting over **96,123** families.

Delivered **6,243** food parcels in Gaza, with an additional **10,000** parcels on the way from Jordan.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal distributed **1,454,000** litres of clean drinking water in Gaza, supporting **145,000** people.

WINTER

Provided **2,000** people in Gaza with mattresses and blankets to prepare for the cold months ahead.

HEALTH

In November, **3,534** people received medical care from our mobile clinics.

Power tools being provided to a young entrepreneur.

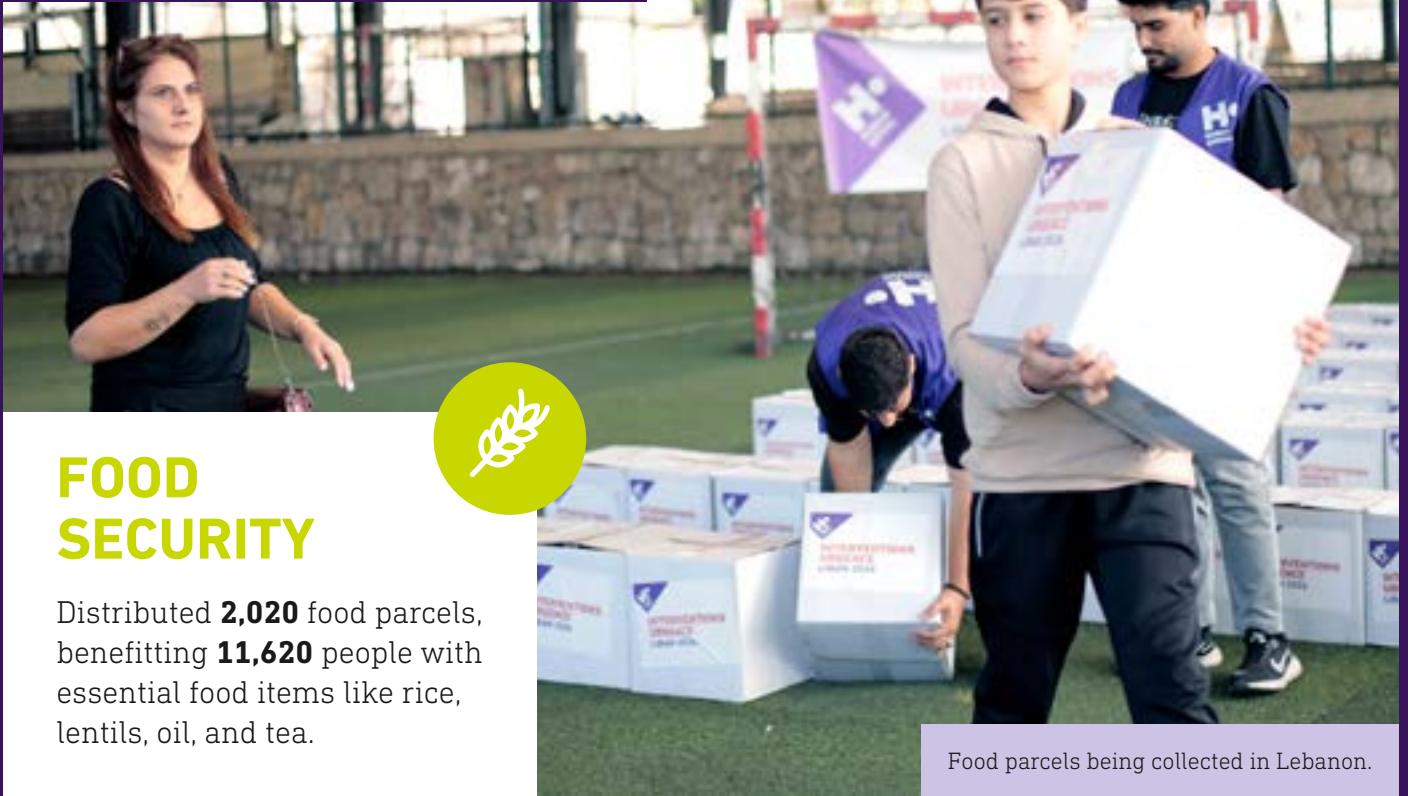


LIVELIHOODS



Trained **73** young people in Iraq's Anbar Province on professional skills and provided in-kind grants to help them start their businesses, such as livestock, seeds, and carpentry tools.

LEBANON



FOOD SECURITY

Distributed **2,020** food parcels, benefitting **11,620** people with essential food items like rice, lentils, oil, and tea.

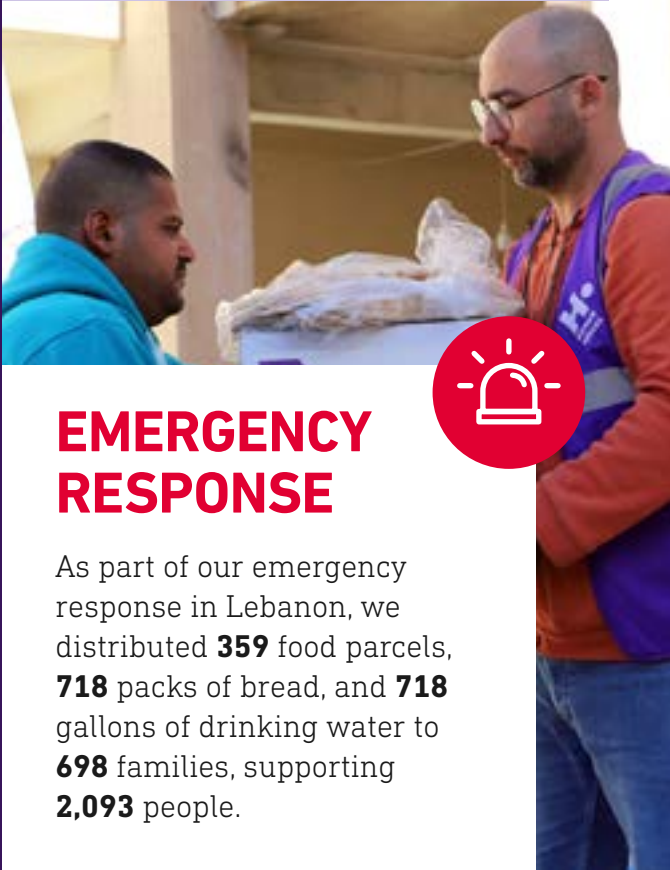


FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **1,885** hot meals to **377** families across four shelters in the south of Lebanon.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

As part of our emergency response in Lebanon, we distributed **359** food parcels, **718** packs of bread, and **718** gallons of drinking water to **698** families, supporting **2,093** people.

WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Supplied hygiene kits to **500** families in Lebanon, supporting **2,500** people in maintaining hygiene under difficult conditions.

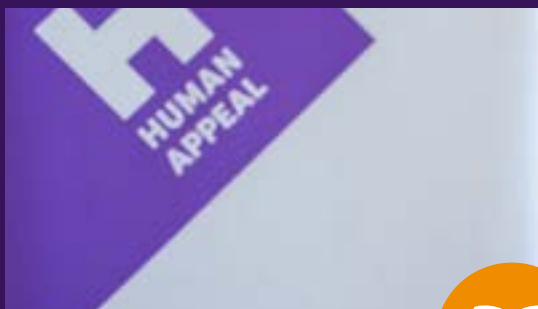


WINTER

We distributed **900** mattresses, **900** blankets and **900** pillows to **180** families across various shelters, ensuring the whole family can stay warm and comfortable during winter.

PAKISTAN



EDUCATION

We distributed **600** back-to-school kits in the town of Chitratopi, Bagh District, Kashmir. Each kit included a rucksack containing notebooks, a geometry set, pencils, pens and a water bottle.

SENEGAL



WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We are constructing **4** additional solar-powered water wells in the region of Seidhiou, following the construction of a solar-powered water well and **10** water points earlier this year, providing **5,000** people in rural villages with safe, sustainable and clean water.

EDUCATION

Began constructing five classrooms in the region of Sedhiou in Senegal to provide students with better learning environments.

CHILD WELFARE

Renovated the Rusfisque Orphanage in Senegal, home to **80** children, ensuring they grow up in a safe, nurturing environment.

SUDAN

WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal distributed **500** hygiene kits to families in the town of Alfaki Hasim in Khartoum Bahri, Sudan.

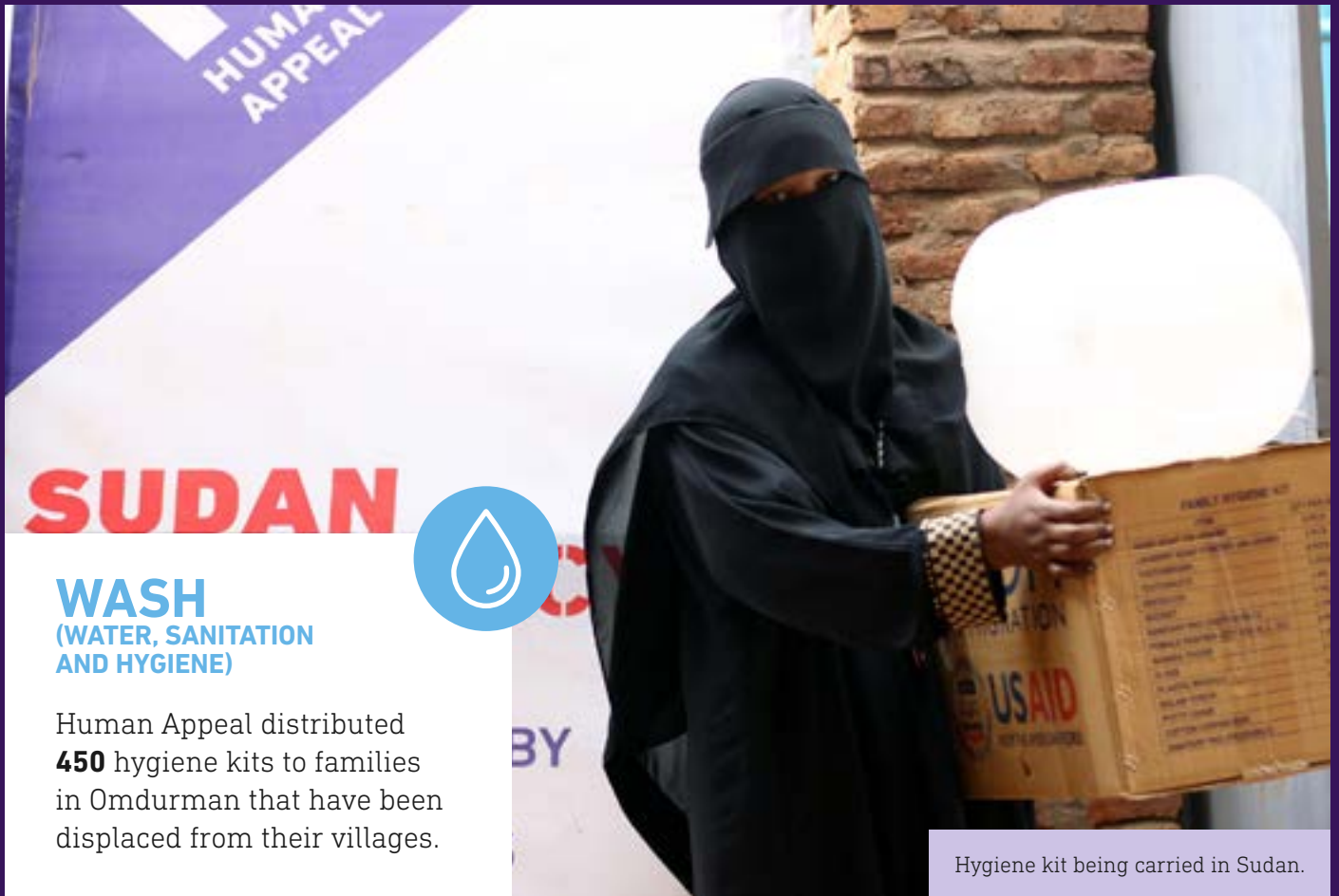


WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

SUDAN

There are now **1,370** students attending Al-Sabr School, the school that Human Appeal constructed in Al-Zohoor village. These children now have a chance to resume their education.

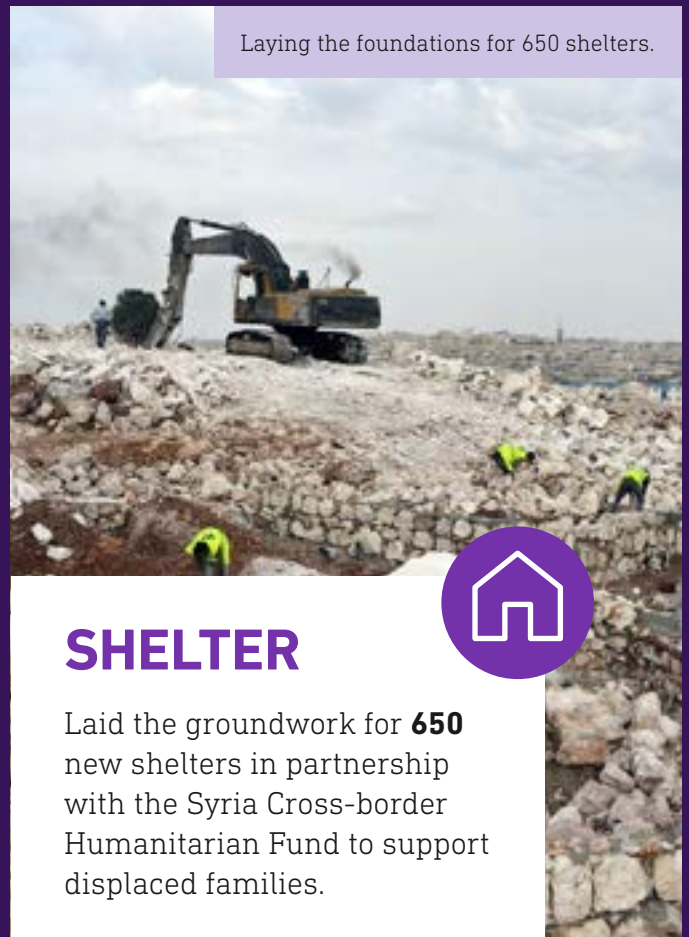


FOOD SECURITY



We distributed **3,873** hot meals in Al-Zohoor village, providing residents with a warm and filling meal.

CHILD WELFARE

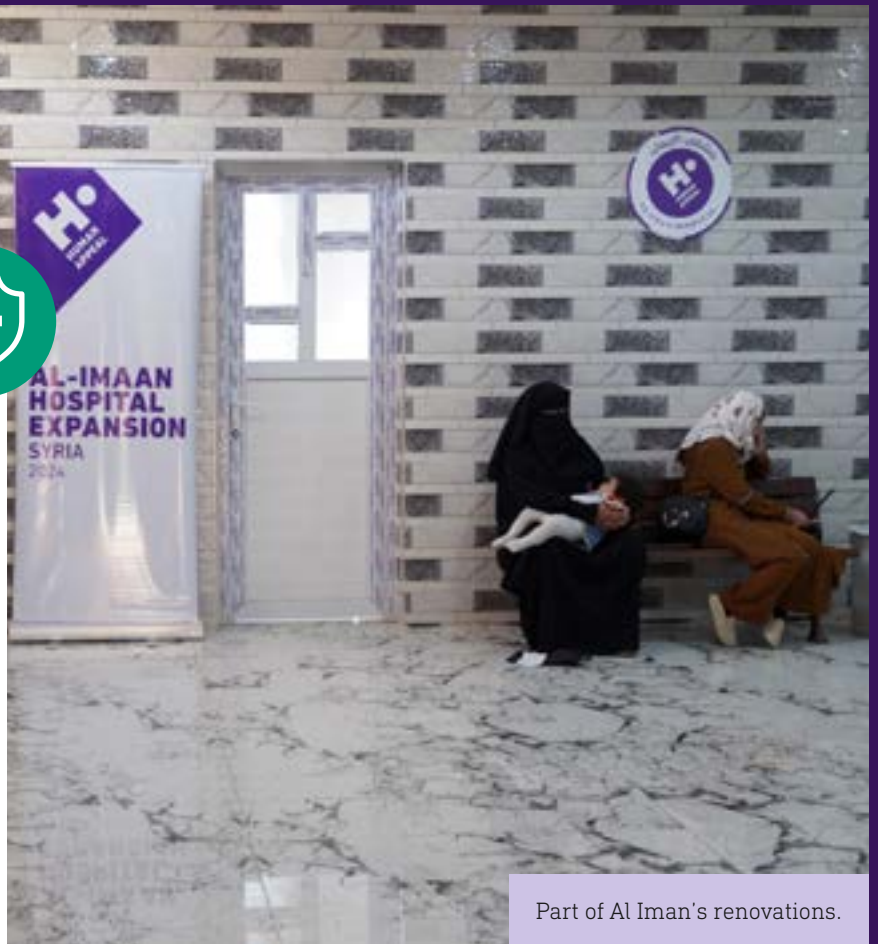


Hosted a painting event for **73** orphans in Syria, giving them an opportunity to express their dreams through art. These paintings will be exhibited and sold, and all the orphans who participated will be sponsored.



HEALTH

Following the renovations of Al Iman Hospital, several clinics and departments have been relocated to make it easier to receive patients. In addition, a room has been designated for the treatment of children with malnutrition as well as a rest room for female patients who have received medical services in the women's clinic.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Set up **50** tents for families fleeing violence in Syria, along with distributing **100** blankets and logistical aid.

TURKEY

CHILD WELFARE



Human Appeal established a child-friendly space for the children of Afghan refugee families. Able to accommodate **20** children at a time, with furniture, stationery and educational toys, it will provide **300** children in the area with a safe space to play and learn. The space will also have an on-site psychologist, who will provide individual counselling to **100** children.

YEMEN



EDUCATION



Launched a back-to-school initiative, distributing **1,595** school kits and uniforms to orphans in Sana'a. Each school bag contained stationery and a water bottle, as well as school uniforms for boys and girls up to the sixth grade.

HEALTH
